- 1.3 Participation in seminars and Department fests.
- 1.4. Exchange of sports and academic materials
- 1.5. Any other relevant programme that are mutually agreed upon.

Sports events

- Both parties agree to exchange their best services and efforts in order to conduct different sports events as a developmental activities which include but are not limited to:
- 2.1. Practice matches
- 2.2. Sports Exhibition
- 2.3. Sports Club.

Costs

 Each Party will be responsible for its own costs in connection with all matters relating to collaborations under this MoU. This agreement may subsequently be withdrawn in case of any financial liabilities.

Confidentiality

4. The parties agree that there is no intention to share any confidential or proprietary information in any collaboration under this MoU. If either Party wishes to disclose information it considers being confidential or proprietary to the other Party, the Party needs to take prior written consent of the other party.

Duration

This MoU is at-will and may be modified by mutual consent of authorized officials from
either side. This MoU shall become effective upon signature by the authorized officials and
will remain in effect until modified or terminated by any one of the authorized officials of the
two institutions.
